POLICIES AND AGREEMENT

Registration

All fees must be paid at registration time. No spot will be reserved without payment. Payment can be made for one or two weeks. For preschool students, payment may be made for full day or half day.

Cancellation

As we are hiring staff based on registration numbers, we regret that no refunds will be possible.

Important Information

What do preschool children need to bring to CIS?

- Sunscreen (****Please have your child arrive with sunscreen already applied**)
- Sleep routine needs for full day students (blanket, pillow)
- Several diapers
- Baby wipes
- Change of clothes
- Arrive wearing clothing and shoes suitable for running and playing
- Hats
- Water bottles

What do elementary students need to bring to CIS?

- Change of clothes
- Shoes they can run in (preferably not flip flops)
- Bathing suit, bathing cap, towel, goggles
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen (****Please have your child arrive with sunscreen already applied**)
- Healthy snack
- Lunch or prepay for lunch in the cafeteria
- Hats

Rules and Regulations

- Please respect pick-up time at 3:00 pm at the end of the day.
- We strive to run a safe, respectful, caring and welcoming environment and all children will be asked to contribute to this environment. If children are unable to follow safety rules or be respectful, parents will be asked to collect their child/ren.
- No medicine will be administered by Summer Explorations staff.
- Parents must bring ID and sign their children in and out of Summer Explorations.
- CIS is a nut-free school as we have students with severe allergies. Do not send any nuts or any items that may contain nuts.
- Library books will not be able to be signed out during summer school.
- If your child is sick, please keep them at home. If your child becomes sick at school, please pick them up and take them home. This will prevent the spread of illness and will allow your child to recover more quickly and comfortably.
- If your child has a temperature of 38C, they must either stay home or be picked up immediately. If your child has had two rounds of diarrhea, they must be picked up and taken home.
- We ask that children are dropped off and that parents or guardians let the child know they are leaving and depart within the first 5 minutes. This will help younger children adapt more quickly and decrease separation anxiety.

Program Details for Elementary

Children in JK and SK will have fun-filled days enhancing their language skills through a variety of activities such as using interesting materials to build, having fun with movement and music, participating in water activities, and creating a variety of art pieces.

Students will participate in up to three different activities in a day or on special days, explore a single topic in more depth. Throughout the sessions, students will be introduced to new activities, be encouraged to take risks, meet new friends, be creative, stretch their imaginations, be active, have fun outside, as well as learn and apply academic skills!
