However, we are sure that you can understand that no plan can be finalized until the Cambodian Government Ministries announce an opening date and the health and safety measures that they expect to see in place.

At present, we do have staff at school and we already have many measures in place to help safeguard them.

The following are the areas that we have taken into account to make our student body as safe as possible when we are permitted to welcome them back on campus:

- Procedures and times for entering and exiting the campuses
- Restricting who may enter a campus
- Health and travel checks required
- Social distancing requirements
- The wearing of masks
- PE and Sport
- Swimming
- Restricting the number of people with whom any one student will come in contact

- The serving and eating of food and drinks
- Transport (buses and buggies)
- ECAs
- Summer Camp
- Field Trips
- Hand hygiene
- CIS / EFI collaboration
- The use and cleaning of equipment
- Cleaning the campuses
- Training of all staff in new procedures
- Discussions with teachers on how to reassure students and to promote a positive, if cautious, outlook
- Educating students in how to look after themselves in the light of COVID-19
